What is the difference between a Full and Small share?

The difference between a Full and Small share is twofold: Full shares receive more food each week, as well as specialty items that are limited in quantity. A small share is not exactly half of the full share, as reflected in the price and thus the name "small share", not "half share." Quantities and price differences fluctuate week to week, so the overall purchase price is determined by averaging share prices from each week at the end of the season. Our top goal is to consistently give our customers the highest quality product. When the farm is bountiful, so is your share. When the weather works against us and crops fail, that can be reflected in your share as well. It is the burden and beauty of being a part of the Community Supported Agriculture model!

Interested in becoming a volunteer shareholder?

We offer a volunteer shareholder position for shareholders who would like to take their commitment to a higher level. "Working Shares," or volunteer shareholders, are asked to support the CSA by harvesting or distributing vegetables for three hours a week (a total of 60 hours for the duration of the season). Keep in mind that these volunteer positions can be physically demanding.

- You must first purchase a vegetable share with the Chatfield Farms CSA.
- You must be onboarded as a Denver Botanic Gardens volunteer to receive the Volunteer Shareholder discount. To be onboarded, you must:
 - Be at least 18 years of age
 - Watch the new volunteer orientation video
 - Complete a volunteer placement interview
 - Complete a background check
 - Optional: Attend a new volunteer onsite tour
