## Easy Butterfly Cupakes

Prepare and bake a dozen cupcakes following boxed cake-mix directions (chocolate, white or yellow cake). Once the cupcakes have cooled, frost each of them with green frosting to resemble grass (white frosting plus food coloring). Next, add four M&Ms down the center of each cupcake to represent the butterfly's body. Antennae can be added using small pieces of Easter grass. Finish with white chocolate pretzels on each side of the M&Ms to make the wings. Enjoy this sweet treat together anytime!
