


The Great JES Book Swap!



Have you read everything in your house? Needing something new for the summer? Join us for The Great JES Book Swap!

Here's what you need to know:

- Bring your unwanted, gently used children's books in a bag with the label below attached to the JES library, May 16—17 and 20th, between 8:00am—9:00am.
- Students should bring in books that are at their grade level. For example, 2nd graders will bring in 2nd grade level books and 4th graders will bring in 4th grade level books. Books that are above or below your child's grade can also be brought but the majority should be suitable for your child's grade. Books should be at least 32 pages long.
- No coloring books, activity books, magazines, comic books, preschool books, such as board books, or books given free in kid's meals. These and books with excessive wear and tear will be returned to the owner and will not count toward their swap total.
- Maximum of 50 books.
- **Fill out completely the information at the bottom of this page and attach it to the bag. All dropped off bags must have this information attached.**
- So that you have lots to choose from, for every 2 books you bring in you will get to select 1 book during the swap. For example, if you bring in ten books you will get to choose five on the day of the swap.
- The Great JES Book Swap will be on Tuesday, May 28.

So look under the bed, in your closets, and in the toy box! Gather up books that you have already read and bring them to the library starting May 16!
