 3 There's not a plant or flower below, but makes thy glories known;


that spread the flowing seas a-broad and built the lofty skies.

 while all that bor-rows life from thee is ev-er in thy care,


the moon shines full at his com-mand, and all the stars o-bey.

Hymn 510 *Come, Holy Spirit, heavenly Dove*




