

Homecoming 2023-Sunset in Santorini

What to wear? The theme for this year's dance will be "Sunset in Santorini" Students should dress in semi-formal attire which is more formal than day-to-day wear. For example, no jeans will be permitted.

Semi-Formal Events Dress Code

There are specific, semi-formal dress requirements for special events including high school dances, periodic fine arts concerts, and the end-of-year ceremonies (such as commencement and graduation).

The semi-formal dress code for young men is as follows: Boys should wear dress slacks (no jeans or patched pocket pants), a dress shirt, tie, dress socks, dress shoes. Dyed/bleached hair is not permitted. Hair should be trimmed and styled appropriately.

The semi-formal dress code for young ladies is as follows: Girls should wear modest-length skirts or dresses (no shorter than the uniform skirt) * or dress pants. Shirts or blouses should be tasteful and appropriate for the occasion. Bare midriffs, tight-fitting outfits, strapless tops, and low-cut tops are not allowed. NOTE: Spaghetti straps will be permitted as long the dress follows the other guidelines.

*NOTE: The uniform skirt should be no more than 2 in above the knee when standing up straight – this means that skirts should go at least as far as the top of your kneecap when standing up straight. The entire hem of your skirt must meet this requirement.

Expectations:

- •The dance runs from 7:00 10:00pm. Admittance closes at 8:00 no exceptions.
- Students must adhere to the dress code in order to be admitted to the dance.
- Student comportment during the dance must be in accordance with usual school expectations.
- Students will remain in areas dedicated to the Dance space throughout the duration of the dance.
- Cell phones should <u>be turned off and put away during the dance</u>. (Students are encouraged to bring digital cameras, and there will be a photo booth with photographers)
