Needed items include:

Microfiber Dust Mops, Feather Dusters, Brooms, Dust Pans, Microfiber Cleaning Cloths, Dish Towels, Canisters for flour/ sugar, Mid-sized Bins to Store Potatoes/ Onions, Tablecloths, Large Fruit Bowl, Measuring Cup (Liquid), Batteries (AA and AAA), Electric Lanterns, Electric Flashlights, Extra Blankets (Twin, Full, Queen), Light Blankets (Twin, Full, Queen), Sheets (Twin, Full, Queen), Cell phone chargers (Type C and Lightning), and Flip Flops.

Higher budget items which could also be gently used include:

Coffee makers, Bicycles (Adult and Child), Cell Phones, Laptops, Backpacks/ Bags, Suitcases, Twin Mattress and Box Spring.
