RESIGNATION

Golf and Clubhouse Member resignations must be in writing and be received by the Board of Governors by January 31st. Tennis Member, including Golfers who play tennis resignations must be in writing and be received by the Board of Governors by October 31st. If not received by the date, the Member tendering such resignation shall be liable for the payment of the annual fee for the then current year, or such proportion as the Board of Governors may determine. A resignation shall not be effective until all indebtedness to the Club has been paid in respect of the resigning Member.

TRANSFERS BETWEEN CATEGORIES – NON MEDICAL

Requests to transfer by Golf and Clubhouse Members must be submitted in writing by January 31st of each year. Requests to transfer by Tennis Members, including Golfers who play tennis must be submitted in writing by October 31st of each year. Transfers between categories will be permitted provided there is a vacancy in the category. The individual transferring will not be permitted to “jump” the waiting list or restricted play list, with the exception of transfers back from “non resident”(see policy below). Members are required to stay in the category they transferred into for at least one (1) year, before requesting a transfer back. If a request to transfer back is prior to the one (1) year requirement, then the member is required to pay the full annual fee they would have paid had they not transferred.

TRANSFERS – NON RESIDENT MEMBERSHIP

Members are required to stay as a Non Resident for at least one (1) year, before requesting a transfer back. If a request to transfer back is prior to the one (1) year requirement, then the member is required to pay the full annual fee they would have paid had they not transferred.

When a Non Resident returns to resident status, they must stay as a resident member for a minimum of 2 years before requesting a transfer back to Non Resident.

TRANSFERS – MEDICAL LEAVE

A medical certificate is required when requesting a medical transfer from all Golf and Tennis member categories. Members are required to remain on medical leave for at least (1) year, prior to transferring back. However, any requests to transfer back to active status prior to the one (1) year period, with payment of the full annual fee they would have paid had they not sought medical leave.

A member on medical leave may play up to three (3) times (accompanied with payment of full green fee) prior to returning to active status or becoming a Clubhouse member. This would give the member the opportunity to confirm his or her ability to return to full “playing” health.

An annual medical attestation of the member’s medical status is required by October 31 to remain on medical leave.

The member will automatically revert to Non-Medical Clubhouse in the event that medical attestation is not provided for member categorization and annual billing purposes by October 31.

The member may elect to transfer to Clubhouse instead of a golf or tennis category. However, it is understood that such a transfer would require the member to be subject to Restricted Play or Waiting List status, if applicable upon his or her ultimate return.

TRANSFERS FROM RESTRICTED PLAY LIST OR WAITING LIST

A Member who transfers to another class of membership while on a Restricted Golf Play List or Golf Waiting List, must remain in the other class of membership for a minimum of one (1) years and will automatically go to the bottom of the Waiting List upon applying for transfer back to golf. If a request to transfer back is prior to the one (1) year requirement, then the member is required to pay the full annual fee they would have paid had they not transferred.

RESTRICTED PLAY LIST

Once a person is placed on any Restricted Play List by way of new memberships or by way of a transfer from another membership category, and have come off the restricted play list in accordance with Club policy, the member is not permitted to make any changes to their membership category or status for a period of a minimum of one year. Medical exceptions will apply in accordance with current Club policy.
