

# Wines OF THE MONTH

## Rosé Château Pesquié 'Terrasses', 2020, Côtes de Ventoux AOC, Rhône Valley, France 6oz 13 | 9oz 19 | Bottle 55

This organic rosé showcases the beautiful aromatics and the funkiness of Cinsault, tempered by the bright fruit of Grenache and the structure of Syrah. Bright strawberry and framboise fruits, medium-bodied richness, and flawless balance.

## Pinot Grigio, DOC, Attems, 2020, Friuli, Italy 45

An impressive fruitiness marks the wine's bouquet, and the palate demonstrates all of the fantastic qualities of the Collio: it has excellent weight and texture and a notable minerality. In addition, it is savoury, tangy, and vibrant.

## Brunello Di Montalcino, 2016 99

Poggio Landi sources grapes from three vineyard locations across the region; Montosoli, La Crociona and Castelverdelli. The 2016 Brunello di Montalcino has aromas of dried red plum, cedar, and pine resin. The palate has a profile of dried cherry, tomato leaf, and Mediterranean herbs, with refreshing acidity and drying tannins.

## Pinot Noir, DeLoach Vineyards, Russian River Valley, 2018, Sonoma County, California 69

Crafted using traditional Burgundian techniques, this Pinot Noir is a medium-bodied wine with moderate tannins and a lingering and mouthwatering finish. The mouthfeel is energetic, revealing fruit and exotic spice in equal measure.

## Cabernet Sauvignon, Ancient Peak, 2019, Paso Robles, California 65

A bold, easy drinking Cabernet from the Paso Robles, California. This Cabernet Sauvignon presents dark fruit aromas of black cherry and cassis with suggestions of black olive, graphite, and tobacco leaf.

## Steady State Cabernet Sauvignon, 2016 Napa Valley California 99

This full bodied 2016 Cabernet is broodingly deep ruby in color. 2016 Steady State shows fragrant notes of cassis buds, ripe red and black cherries, as well as warm, complex aromas of blackberry brambles, wild rosemary and lavender.
