Our Theme is - "Transforming Healthcare - Exploring the Current Challenges and Possibilities in Nursing"

We invite deans, directors, chairs, faculty, nurses, and academic administrators to submit an abstract for an upcoming conference. Wilson Shepard Education Associates requests submissions showcasing programs, courses, initiatives and/or evaluation strategies that characterize the conference theme and address the many changes and challenges faced in nursing. This conference for 2024 is comprised of keynote and speaker's sessions on latest cutting edge research designed to offer comprehensive global discussions that address current issues in Nursing.

The 2024 Transforming Healthcare will focus on the critical issues facing nursing education today, with topics to help educators prepare for nursing's exciting future. This year, WSHEP will be looking for topics specific to our policy principles established to enhance and support growth in nursing education. The categories and subcategories we are seeking podium presentations for are as follows:

#### 1. Promote the Nursing Profession

Abstracts must describe completed projects, and all work should be original.

Abstracts may take the following forms:

1. **Research Abstract:** Abstract representing a complete research study, which includes an introduction to the overall topic under investigation, clearly stated purpose, background information to support the purpose or hypothesis of the study, a concise description of the methodology and results, and a sound

conclusion, which is directly connected to the purpose of the study. The results of the research study should clearly impact or benefit nursing education. The study may be any one of the following:

1. *Qualitative*
2. *Quantitative*
3. *Mixed Methods*
4. *Integrative Review/Meta-analysis*

2. **Evidence-Based Best Practice Abstract:** Abstract representing an educational process, strategy, or practice innovation that represents a change leading to achievement of a desired outcome or meeting a benchmark for nursing education and/or student learning outcomes.

3. **Evidence-Based Teaching Strategy Abstract:** Abstract representing strategies or teaching innovations in any setting to solve an academic problem related to student learning.

**Presentations should take the form of a 60-minute standard interactive session.**
