### Applicable to Podium sessions

- Presentation will be 30"- 20" presentation, 10" Q & A

Primary presenter must provide an e-mail address for all co-presenters/co-authors after submitting an abstract proposal

- A needs assessment statement,
- Three learning objectives and 5 keywords
- Abstract summary will be required. Abstract should contain evidence-based guidelines, best available evidence, and/or nursing research to add meaningful and supportive data.
- Content outline construction
  - Evidence based practice: purpose, description and evaluation outcome
  - Research – purpose, background significance, methods, results, and conclusion
- For research projects, please include a discussion of background, methods, results, conclusions, and references.
- For clinical or practice abstracts, please include a discussion of evidence-based practice and references.
