Normal operating hours for the on-site medical clinic are Monday-Saturday, 5:30 a.m.-7:30 p.m.


Vogtle 3&4 COVID-19 Testing Update

Since Monday, June 1, we have been notified of one additional individual who has tested positive for COVID-19.

Site leadership will continue to closely monitor conditions using the data available and will draw on the expertise of health officials, including the latest recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the medical professionals providing guidance specifically for our Vogtle 3&4 team.

The proactive measures we've implemented throughout this pandemic to limit the spread of the virus and protect the health and safety of our workforce will continue and evolve based on any new information and guidelines.

Starting next week, we will be transitioning to a once a week COVID-19 update.

Medical Clinic Information

- **On-site medical clinic:** The clinic should only be used by those who are showing symptoms and/or feeling ill to allow us to treat those personnel as quickly as possible.
 - Free testing, no copays and access to dedicated medical professionals
 - Open Monday-Saturday, 5:30 a.m.-7:30 p.m.

- Wait time for COVID test results: 24-48 hours

If you are feeling ill, you can also call the flu hotline at 706-437-7600. In case of a medical emergency on the construction site, call the Emergency Response Team at 706-360-2510. In case of a medical emergency at home, call 911.

- **Close-proximity testing requires reservations:** A reservation hotline has been set up to accommodate appointments for workers who have been in close proximity to another worker who has tested positive for COVID-19.
 - Those who are eligible will be notified that they are able to receive a COVID-19 test at the onsite medical clinic.
 - Reservations may be made Monday-Friday by calling 706-437-7679 or 706-437-7670.

Scheduling close proximity-associated testing helps improve the efficiency of our medical clinic as we aim to provide each worker that may be feeling ill with the care they need.
