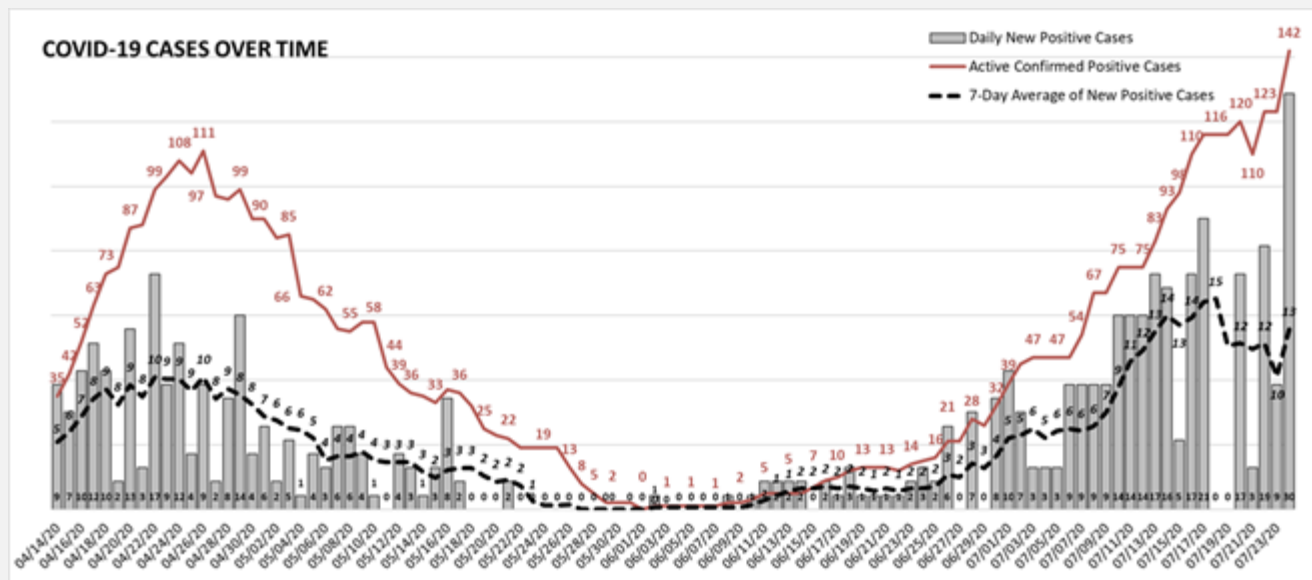
## Vogle 3&4 COVID-19 Testing Update

Since Tuesday, July 21, we have been notified of 58 additional individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19.

Site leadership will continue to closely monitor conditions using the data available and will draw on the expertise of health officials, including the latest recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the medical professionals providing guidance specifically for our Vogle 3&4 team.

The proactive measures we've implemented throughout this pandemic to limit the spread of the virus and protect the health and safety of our workforce will continue and evolve based on any new information and guidelines.

*Due to the significant increase in tests administered in surrounding communities, tests may take longer to process and cause the results from tests administered over several days to be reported on one day. We will continue to utilize dedicated couriers and off-site labs to continue to track processing and receive results in the timeliest manner possible.*

**On-site medical clinic:** The clinic should only be used by those who are showing symptoms and/or feeling ill to allow us to treat those personnel as quickly as possible.

- Free testing, no copays and access to dedicated medical professionals
- Open Monday-Saturday, 5:30 a.m.-7:30 p.m.
- Wait time for COVID test results: 24-48 hours
