

- The PFES mission is *to respond in a safe manner to all reported emergencies of our citizens and to protect lives and property through fire prevention, public education and the mitigation of emergencies and disasters whether natural or man-made.*
- We respond to all types of emergencies including structure fires, grass fires, medical calls, vehicle accidents, hazardous materials, etc.
- Operate within an approx. \$2.8M annual budget
- ISO Class 4 with 2 fire stations
- PFD is organized into 3 Divisions:
- Administration
 - Fire Chief Lee Parker
 - Executive Assistant Anji Holley
- Responsible for overall leadership and management of the department as well as planning, budgeting, and other administrative functions.
- Operations (Fire Protection)
 - Battalion Chiefs/Shift Commander
 - 1 Captain, 2 Lieutenants and 9 Firefighters on duty per day between 2 fire stations
- Provides fire protection, rescue services, and medical first responder service to over 15 thousand citizens in a service coverage area of over 27 square miles. With the growth of Perry, the division now handles over 2000 emergency incidents a year.
- With approximately 20 EMT's and 4 Paramedics, the department utilizes Basic Life Support equipment and supplies on all Fire Engines and Ladder Trucks. This gives these EMT's and Paramedics the resources they need to deliver a level of medical care as a part of their first response to an incident...
- Medical calls account for about 70% of all responses.
- Fire Marshal's Office (Fire Prevention)
 - Battalion Chief/Fire Marshal
- Responsible for plans review of new or remodeled commercial occupancies, Fire Code enforcement, Fire Inspections and Fire Investigations.
