### **SUMMARY:**

- The City of San Jose has activated the Emergency Operations Center.
- The National Weather Service has issued a flood warning for the Guadalupe River area. A Flash Flood Watch is still in effect for Ross Creek at Cherry Ave.
- Residents in the following areas are **ENCOURAGED TO EVACUATE IMMEDIATELY** due to threat of flooding: Guadalupe River area from Willow Glen Way to Atlanta Avenue.
- It is urgent and important for residents in these areas to evacuate to the homes of family or friends, or to San Jose's designated evacuation center at Willow Glen Community Center, 2175 Lincoln Avenue. Standby for additional messages and visit [www.sanjoseca.gov](http://www.sanjoseca.gov) for more detailed information. Residents in areas not named for evacuation should remain in place, be alert to changing conditions.
- If residents do not have a form of transportation VTA buses will be available at two pick-up points to transport residents to Willow Glen Community Center.
- From 3:30 – 5:30 A.M., 2 VTA buses will be available at Starlite Banquet. Center, 680 Minnesota Ave.
- From 3:30 - 5:30 A.M., 1 VTA bus at will be available at Transfiguration Church, 4325 Jarvis Ave.
- Bring important documents, medicines, spare clothes.
- Pets are welcome, bring a portable kennel if you have one.
- If you or a neighbor need special assistance to evacuate, please call 408-535-3500.
