- PG&E has alerted County and City officials about the potential for a PG&E Public Safety Power Shutoff event impacting 29 counties in Northern California, including approximately 38,000 customer accounts in Santa Clara County.
- PG&E forecasts high winds and low humidity on Wednesday, October 9 through noon on Thursday, October 10. PG&E could turn off power as soon as midnight on Wednesday (late Tuesday night). Full power restoration could take up to 5 days.

You can also search for your address to determine whether it may be affected. In San Jose, PG&E projects parts of the east foothills and south San Jose to be affected.
- Residents and businesses should prepare for up to 7 days without power. For tips on how to prepare, visit www.sanjoseca.gov/index.aspx?NID=6380 or www.pge.com/psps.
- The City has a Power Vulnerability Plan to prepare for and respond to PG&E PSPS events. City staff are monitoring the situation and coordinating with the County and PG&E. The City will activate its Emergency Operations Center Tuesday evening.
- PG&E will open a Community Resource Center (CRC) on Wednesday at Avaya Stadium (1145 Coleman Ave). The CRC will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for the duration of the event and provide customers with information, water, charging stations, and air conditioning.
