Background:	San José community centers are vital assets that provide residents with a safe place during emergencies. When temperatures reach 97 degrees, the community centers serve as “cooling centers” and extend their hours. All residents are encouraged to beat the heat at their local center during the current heat warning. While cooling down, residents can explore specialized programming at each site.
