During this session, participants will discuss facts concerning mental health and suicide prevention, recognize warning signs of those who may be thinking about suicide, learn how to ask the question about suicide, and understand how to make a referral to the proper resources. All participants will leave this session with their QPR Suicide Prevention Gatekeeper certification.</i>
