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WHEN TO STAY HOME

- If you have been diagnosed or tested positive for COVID-19, regardless of vaccination and symptom status.
- If a household member has tested positive COVID-19, see household contact
- You are experiencing symptoms.

SYMPTOM SCREENING (not limited to)

cough, shortness of breath,
difficulty breathing, sore throat,
fever chills, muscle aches/pains,
loss of taste or smell, headache,
nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea

IF SYMPTOMS DEVELOP

- Contact Nicole Klein
- Do not attend school until:
- Cleared by a medical provider OR
 - Have a negative lab confirmed PCR test OR
 - 5-10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared
- AND
- Free of fever without the use of medicine for at least 24 hours

HOUSEHOLD CONTACT

- Contact Nicole Klein
- Unvaccinated and/or Symptomatic:
- 5 to 20 day quarantine based on isolation.
 - Quarantine starts after positive case's quarantine has ended, unless isolated.
- Fully Vaccinated:
- If symptom free, may attend school and monitor symptoms for 14 days.

CLOSE CONTACT DEFINITION

- Exposure within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes (24 hour period)
- 48 hours before the onset of symptoms when the COVID positive person or 48 hours before test date, if asymptomatic

SCHOOL CLOSE CONTACT/COMMUNITY CLOSE CONTACT

- Email will be given for school close contacts
- Community close contact-contact Nicole Klein
- Monitor for symptoms for 14 days
- If symptom free, quarantine or attending school are options
- If symptoms develop, follow procedure above.

DEFINITION OF FULLY VACCINATED

- Have been boosted OR
- Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months OR
- Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months

NOTIFICATIONS

- Families will continue to get an email notification when there is a positive COVID case in their child's grade level.
- Parents will continue to be contacted through email if their child is considered a school close contact, so they are able to make informed decisions.

SMV Guidance According to CDC

***Contact Nicole Klein with positive test results, household contacts, updates or any questions.**

****Day 0 is the first day of symptoms, test day, or last day with covid positive person.**

If You Test Positive for COVID-19 (Isolate)

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| Everyone, regardless of vaccination status. | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Stay home for 5 days from the onset of your covid suspect symptoms or covid positive test if asymptomatic. Day 0 is the test day or first day of symptoms.• If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can return to school/work.• You are required to wear a well-fitting mask around others for 5 additional days at school. A surgical mask or a KN95 is recommended as opposed to a cloth mask.• If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.• If you are unwilling/unable to mask while at school you are required to isolate yourself at home through day 10 and may return on day 11. |
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If You Were a Close Contact to Someone with COVID-19 in Your Household (Quarantine)

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| If you: Have been boosted OR Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months OR Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• It is recommended you wear a well-fitted mask around others for 10 days after your close contact with the covid positive person. A surgical mask or a KN95 is recommended as opposed to a cloth mask.• Test on day 5, if possible.• If you develop covid suspect symptoms, get a test and stay home. |
| If you: Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted OR Completed the primary series of J&J over 2 months ago and are not boosted OR Are unvaccinated | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Stay home for an <u>additional</u> 5 days after the date of your last close contact with a covid positive person.• If you are symptom free after those 5 days, you can go to school.• You are required to wear a well-fitted mask around others for 5 additional days at school. A surgical mask or a KN95 mask is recommended as opposed to a cloth mask.• Test on day 5 if possible.• If you develop covid suspect symptoms, get a test and stay home.• If you are unwilling/unable to wear a mask for the additional 5 days, you shall quarantine for 7 days and may return on day 8 with a negative test result from days 5-7. <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>Quarantine for 10 days and return on day 11 without a test from a certified entity if asymptomatic.</p> |
