Please **remain in the classrooms** after the completion of each round. Please listen carefully for an announcement over the P.A. system to proceed to the next round.

Remember, when you walk through the hallways, please be as quiet as possible. Even through a closed classroom door, the noise can be very distracting to the students still making their presentations.

We will be using the evaluation form used at the Jr. High level for outside meets. It provides a valuable critique of each student's performance. The judges will adjust their critiques to make them appropriate for the elementary level.
