On-line Registration begins May 4, 2019, 8:00 a.m.

In-Person Registration: May 4, 2019, 8:00—10:00 a.m. and continuing during regular office hours until camps fill.

Mail-in Registration postmarked on or after May 4, 2019 are opened and processed randomly the next business day.

What are the Activities at Camp?

Discovery Camp and Day Camp offers swimming, camp crafts, nature lore, sports and games, hiking, special events, quiet activities, exploring and enjoying the outdoors. These programs offer outdoor fun with an emphasis on nature, development, and outdoor skills. Our energetic leaders are composed of experienced college students, graduates, and teachers. All programs are designed for the age/grade group attending. Grade is based on the 2018/19 school year to be eligible.

Who's Eligible?

City of Brookfield Residents who reside:

- in or own property in Brookfield and
- Elmbrook School District Residents individuals who live outside of the City of Brookfield but within the Elmbrook School District boundaries.
- Non-residents—individuals who do not reside in either the City of Brookfield or Elmbrook School District may register for camp one week prior to the camp start date if openings are available.
- Participants must enroll for the appropriate grade group. Grade groups are determined by grade of child as of April 2018.

Leadership

Camp activities are under the direction of Program Coordinator, Debi Maxfield, and each camp will have a Camp Supervisor. Camp Counselors assist these individuals. Staff to camper ratio is as follows:

Discovery Camp – 1:10 (50 max) Day Camp – 1:15 (75 max)

Boys and girls will be grouped with others of their own age/grade and will be directly supervised by an adult counselor as they explore and experience a wide variety of camp activities. The campers are involved in large-group activities that allow participation with friend(s).

Accessibility/ADA

The City of Brookfield Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department will make reasonable accommodations for people with disabilities to utilize department programs, facilities, and services in accordance with Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Programs are offered through specialized programs and inclusion opportunities. In order to best serve your individual needs, we ask that you notify us of any accommodations needed at the time of registration or at least two weeks before the program begins.

What if it Rains?

Discovery and **Day Camp** will be held within the park buildings and shelters at Wirth Park if there is a very light or intermittent rain.

Your child may be delivered to Picnic Area #9 (Discovery Camp) or #6 (Day Camp) where a decision about the day's location will be made.

Camp sessions will be canceled in the case of steady or heavy rain or other severe weather.

Decisions on operation will be made prior to each morning or afternoon session and will be recorded on the Recreation Newsline, (414)297-9565 and the City website, www.ci.brookfield.wi.us. There will be no make-up sessions or refunds due to inclement weather.

Registration Process

On-line Registration Opens May 4, 2019 at 8:00 a.m. Eligible to Elmbrook School District Residents Only.

(Requires completion of the Household Information Form if you do not already have your User Name and Password).

Payment will be by credit card. Individuals may register online and in person members of their family household only.

Mail-in / Drop Off Registration: Mail-in or drop off will be processed randomly the next business day received. A household information form must be on file with our office and the program fee (cash or check) attached.

Complete the registration form (front and back) and send with check(s) for each person and camp for which you are registering. The cost per session is listed on backside of the registration form.

Registration is limited to three sessions for Discovery Camp, two sessions for Day Camp until June 3.

Registration for more sessions is permitted on June 3 as space allows.
