DIY Story Times - Monthly do-it-yourself story time packets are available both in the library and on the library website at [DIY Story Time](#). In addition to a collection of songs, rhymes and book suggestions, packets contain ideas for making the most of reading time with your child.

Book Bundles - If you don't have time to browse for new children's books, or you just need fresh suggestions, book bundles are the answer! When you request a book bundle, a librarian will select 4-5 books for your child based on your preferences. The books will then be put on hold for you to pick up at the Elm Grove library or receive curbside, and you will be notified when the books are ready. Winter Reading - From January 1st to 31st, the Elm Grove Library will participate in Beanstack's Winter Reading Challenge, "Books Like Us," sponsored by Simon and Schuster (S&S). We challenge our community to read at least **6,000 minutes** (all of us together) during the month and keep track of your reading on our Beanstack site at elmgrovelibrary.beanstack.org. Thousands of libraries and schools across the nation will encourage their communities to read a target number of minutes for prizes that will include book collections and virtual author visits. This is a reading challenge for **ALL AGES** (children through adult) and if you registered for Beanstack in the summer you don't need to re-register, you can just log into the same account to join the challenge.
