Reports: Assessing Progress on our 2018 Goals

Major Projects:

- The Rectory:
 - Replacement of the windows has been contracted; to begin in October/November
 - Abatement repair has been contracted; to begin in early September
- The Organ Fund
 - 3 Benefit Concerts have been scheduled for the Fall, 2018
 - Maintenance and minor repairs have been contracted for 2018, and projected maintenance plan is being prepared prior to the 2019 budget
- The Elevator: Research is in process on options for repair and funding
- Security System has been contracted for installation in September or October

Sunday School/Youth and Family Ministries (T2T, Fx3):

- Marisol Ortega – Sunday School Liaison
 - We were not able to include more youth in the LUW camp or Episcopal Youth Camp. An information meeting is planned for early 2019 to encourage greater participation in the summer of 2019
 - We continue to explore ways to improve communication and coordination with La Gracia and Grace classes & activities
- Amy Auld Owens – Liason for Fx3
 - Plans are in place for family apple-picking and supporting Santa's Workshop

Stewardship: Charlotte Roberson, Chair

- The database and pledging lists are being reviewed for Exploring channels for increased funding
- The 2019 campaign will strengthen year-round Stewardship education

Welcoming / Project Connect/ECW: Trisha McGuinness:

- The Chair of Welcoming and Trish will prepare a proposal for the September Vestry meeting clarifying the purpose and ministry of the Welcoming Committee and reviewing the expectations for Coffee Hour hosts
- We are continuing to work on Improving communication with La Gracia
- We are updating and improving our Bulletin Boards

- Grace Church will participate in the county-wide Voter Registration Drive on Friday September 21st and on a Sunday in October

- Improving communication between Vestry and different worship leadership groups by means of monthly reports has given them a voice in church governance.
- Training will be planned this fall for ushers & acolytes, and we will introduce more clear rubrics for worship in the service leaflet beginning in September

- We continue to monitor the budget quarterly
- We have not developed fundraising proposals because of the focus on fundraising for the organ fund
- We continue to encourage and applaud the rich a variety of music during worship, and we will continue to encourage new membership in both the adult choir and the St. Nicholas Choir
