



Q2 What are the ages of the children in your household?



Q3 Are you a resident of Sterling Ranch?



Q4 Have you ever visited the following existing parks/open spaces in Providence Village?



Q5 Which of the following parks is closest to your home?



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

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

Q10 How frequently do you or your children (if any) visit the park that you use the MOST?



Q11 In general, do you come to the existing parks alone or with others?



Q12 Would you or your children (if any) be interested in an event or organized program in any of the existing parks in Providence Village? If so, what programs and/or events?



Q13 How often do you visit nearby Chatfield State Park?





Q15 As new parks are developed in future Filings at Sterling Ranch, how far would you be willing to travel to visit one of the new parks if it had an amenity that you were interested in?







Q19 If outdoor fitness equipment were to be placed along some of the trails or within parks, would you use it?






