

Saints Peter and Paul Religious Education Registration Guidelines 2022/2023

2022/2023 CLASSES START TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 13 AND WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 14

- 1. The following registration documents should be completed and submitted on or before May 27, 2022. Deadlines will be strictly adhered to. Some classes and days fill quickly even before the deadline so please register as soon as possible.
- 2. The registration is not considered complete and will not be processed until all paperwork is turned in:

Registration Form -Fill in information for each child you are registering, being sure to
indicate which session you are requesting.
Tuition and Fee Worksheet
Payment – Check or Credit Card Authorization Form
Family and Medical Info Form
Volunteer Form

- 3. Once the registration has been processed you will receive an email verifying the grade level and class session of your child's placement. Please check it carefully and notify us immediately of any issues. Specific class placements (catechist name and room number) will be sent after Labor Day.
- 4. If you need to change a class session after submitting your registration, you are asked to submit a request online (see RE page of parish website) so that changes can be handled in the order they are received. Changes to class sessions after initial submission of a family's registration will be made space permitting until July 31, 2022. For change requests submitted beginning August 1st, and if we are able to accommodate your request, a \$50.00 processing fee will be assessed and must be paid prior to the change being made. NO CLASS CHANGES WILL BE MADE AFTER SEPTEMBER 1ST.

Classes will not be overloaded to accommodate changes in class days if open spots are still available on another day. Additional classes will be added only if space and available volunteers permit.

- 5. Class placements will be sent the week after Labor Day using the email(s) and cell number(s) provided on the registration paperwork. Requests for placement with specific teachers or classmates cannot be honored.
- 6. If financial assistance is required, please request a tuition assistance form. Please do not delay submitting your registration due to financial difficulty.

Additional Registration Guidelines For Newly Registered Families



- A copy of the baptismal certificate is required for any child who is new to the RE program if he or she was not baptized at Sts. Peter and Paul. New students will not be admitted to the program without a baptismal certificate.
- 2. Because the Religious Education program is subsidized by the parish using parishioner donations, families should be registered members of Saints Peter and Paul Parish. Non-parishioners will be accepted for registration with an additional \$100 per family charge.
- 3. Students who are entering our program from another Catholic religious education program or Catholic school are required to present a letter or other acknowledgement from that program or school indicating length of time in the program, the last level completed, and dates of any sacraments received. This aids us in placing the child in the proper grade level. A written or oral assessment may be made to determine appropriate placement, particularly for those entering the Confirmation program.

If your child did not participate in a program previously, registration will be made on a case basis dependent on date starting and grade level.

4. Students transferring from another Naperville/local parish may not be admitted to the program after July 31, 2022 pending availability of space.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTIONS

The ability to place children in classes is contingent on sufficient volunteers, both in the classroom and in other capacities. Volunteers receive discounts on tuition. Please consider one of the many opportunities available.

CATECHIST – Prepares and teaches lesson to class. Catechists are provided with training, lesson plans and all other materials. Weekly commitment

ASSISTANT – Supports catechist in classroom by taking attendance; collecting and grading homework and other miscellaneous activities. Weekly commitment

SAFETY MONITOR - Monitor students and others entering and leaving building; collect attendance rosters from classrooms. Ensure safety of children and adults at the parish crosswalks before, during and after class. Weekly or biweekly commitment

CHILDCARE HELPER – Help care for the younger children of program volunteers during class time. Weekly or bi-weekly commitment
