Full Job Description:

Responsible for the daily operations of a company of 8 actors, ages 16-19, who perform daily shows of a one-act musical theater production; drives a modified 15-passenger van to various school and community center locations in Prince George's County; supervises the loading and unloading of sets, props, sound equipment and costumes; operates the sound system during each performance; acts as Assistant to the Director during rehearsals; supervises and collects time cards from the actors; coordinates the daily schedule, and other duties as assigned.

Duties:

Report to Publick Playhouse daily to pick up actors. Drive 15-passenger van to assigned Community Center. Supervise actors, who unload and set up staging, lighting, and sound equipment as designated. Maintain proper safety protocols. Coordinate with Camp staff. Operate sound system during performance. Supervise load-out of all sets and equipment at end of performance.

Qualifications:

Experience supervision of young people in high school theater programs, or other teaching experience, very desirable. Experience handling electrical sound equipment. Must have clean driving record and take Defensive Driving Training.
