CONVENTION INFORMATION

At 6 PM, we begin our evening activities with *Motown in the Moonlight*, a special reception that includes hors d'oeuvres and a cash bar. This wonderful evening starts with our Golden Awards, given to members of 50 years or more. To add to this fun and relaxing evening, we will play Motown Music Bingo for great prizes. We would love for you to join us and sing along with these memorable tunes.

On Saturday, May 11, we will serve you breakfast in the morning before the convention, which starts promptly at 9 AM with our first keynote: nationally renowned presenter, Lisa Maatz. Then you can choose from eight different breakout sessions across three categories: Leadership; PR and Social Media, and Recruitment/Diversity.

Following a delicious lunch, which is included in the cost of your convention ticket, we will hold our awards ceremony.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q	A
How can my branch get involved in this event?	First, your members can register to attend the convention and our Friday night event. For the first time ever, we are not using delegates for voting! Every vote counts! Second, we will have tables available for branches wishing to sell items. You can place an ad for your branch in our Convention Program. Lastly, we are doing raffles so, if your branch would like to donate a raffle item/basket, we would appreciate this.
What do I need to bring with me to these events?	You will not have to print anything at home to bring with you. We will have everything you need there. However, since we are doing raffles, branches are selling items and we have a cash bar, it is a good idea to bring cash to the event.
How are the prices for these events set?	Once venue, food, printing, presenter fees and other costs are known, we estimate the number of potential ticket sales to determine a price that allows us to break even. While we occasionally are able to use this event as a small fundraiser, there is no expectation that will generate large proceeds. We do our best to keep prices affordable because our attendees make this event a success. Post-COVID cost increases have impacted our event pricing greatly.
What kind of prizes are available?	Our grand prize is an elegant women's watch valued at \$700. We anticipate various prizes at a variety of values, including baskets of misc. items, books, AAUW merchandise, etc. Raffles are a fundraiser for AAUW of Michigan. Music Bingo prizes are available as well. Attendees also will receive free items, including a drawstring backpack of AAUW goodies.
