

"JHS Rebuild Update" by Susan Baird-Joshi

Now that the 2016 bond passed for a new JHS, the district is in the design phase for a new campus. Brian Buck, in his fourth year in Facility Services, said the district will be having another community meeting tied to the design phase to receive input about the new building and the transition campus.

Buck, who worked at Boeing Co. for more than 20 years in Boeing's Shared services group, said the original plan for the JHS rebuild was a "big bang" approach--tearing down the old building and constructing the new all at once. But now they were considering other approaches. Any option would include a transition building with a portable campus.
