

Fear Free Practice SAT & ACT Tests

The Juanita High School PTSA and The Princeton Review have partnered to provide the opportunity for students to take a “Fear Free” practice ACT and/or SAT test. Scores are not reported to anyone other than the student. Within 2 weeks, students return for a Test Review session. They will receive their graded tests along with the answer key so they can determine their strengths and weaknesses.

Registration Deadline: February 15, 2017 or until all spots are filled

Test Review Session: Thursday, March 9, 2017, 7:00 - 8:30 pm.

Practice ACT Test

Test Session: Saturday, January 7, 2017, 8:30 am - 1:00 pm

Registration Deadline: December 16, 2016 or until all spots are filled

Test Review Session: Thursday, January 19, 2017, 7:00 - 8:30 pm.
