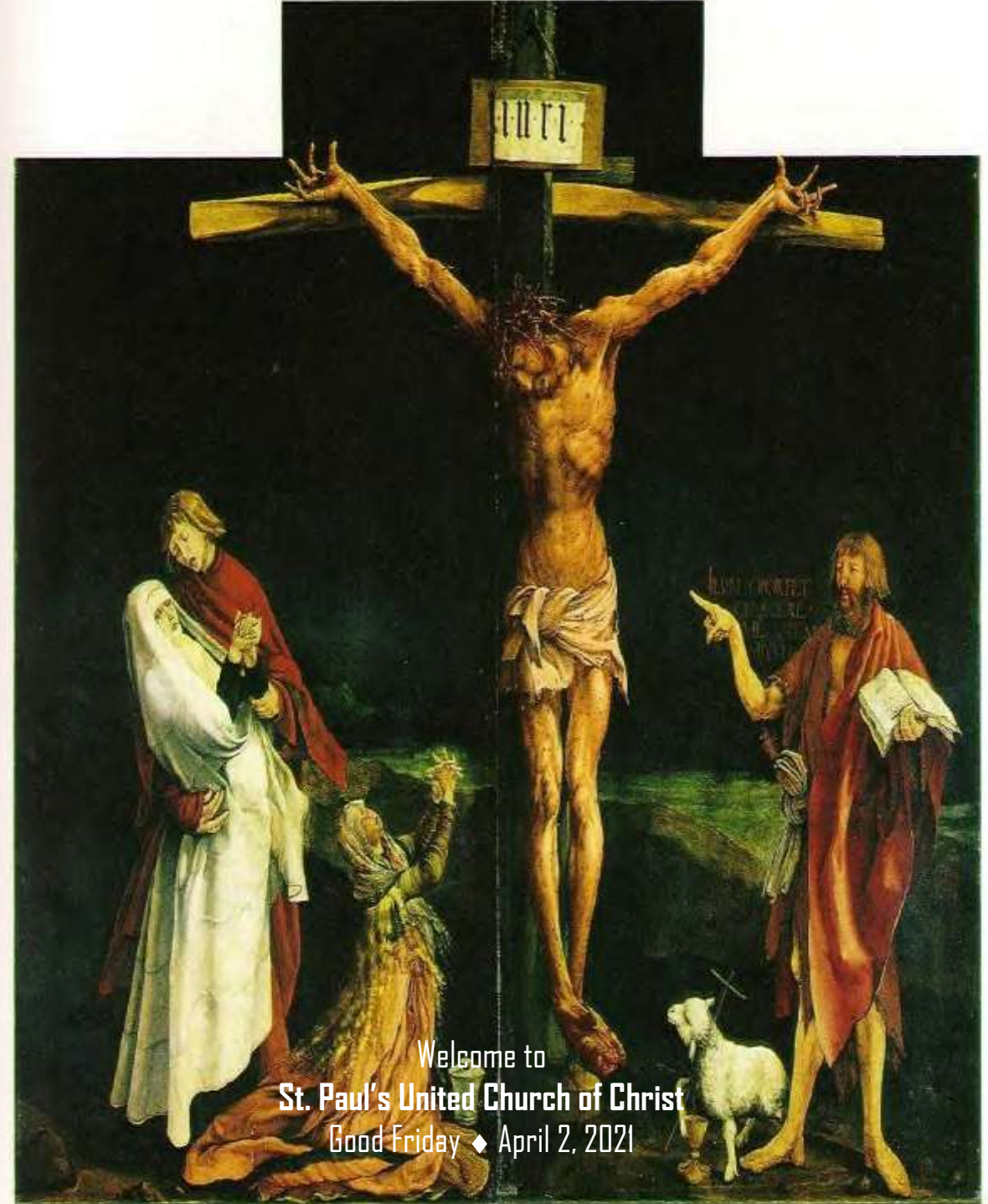

Part I: "Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do." - St. Luke 23:34

Part II: "Today you shall be with Me in Paradise." - St. Luke 23:43

**P: 1. Jesus, pit-y-ing the sighs of the thief who near Him dies, promising him Paradise; Hear us, Holy Jesus. May we in our guilt and shame, still your love and mercy claim. 2. Calling humbly on Your Name: Hear us, Holy Jesus. 3. May our hearts to You incline, looking from our cross to Thine: Cheer our souls with hope divine: Hear us, Holy Jesus.**

Part III: "Woman, behold your son! Behold your mother!" - St. John 19:26, 27

**P: 1. Jesus, loving to the end her whose heart your sorrows rend, and your dearest human friend: Hear us, Holy Jesus. 2. May we in your sorrows share, for your sake all peril dare, and enjoy your tender care: Hear us, Holy Jesus. 3. May we all your loved ones be, all one holy family, loving for the love of Thee: Hear us, Holy Jesus.**

Part IV: "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?" - St. Matthew 27:46

**P: 1. Jesus, wrapped in fears unknown, with our evil left alone, while no light from heaven is shown, Hear us, Holy Jesus. 2. When we seem in vain to pray, and our hope seems far away, in the darkness be our stay: Hear us, Holy Jesus. 3. Though no Father seem to hear, though no light our spirits cheer, may we know that God is near: Hear us, Holy Jesus.**

Part V: "I thirst" - St. John 19:28



1. Je - sus, in Thy thirst and pain, While Thy wounds Thy life - blood drain,  
2. Thirst for us in mer - cy still; All Thy ho - ly work ful - fill;  
3. May we thirst Thy love to know; Lead us in our sin and woe  
Thirst - ing more our love to gain: Hear us, Ho - ly Je - sus.  
Sat - is - fy Thy lov - ing will: Hear us, Ho - ly Je - sus.  
Where the heal - ing wa - ters flow: Hear us, Ho - ly Je - sus. A-MEN.

Part VI: "It is finished." - St. John 19:30

**P: 1. Jesus, all our ransom paid, all Your Father's will obeyed; by Your suffering perfect made: Hear us, Holy Jesus. 2. Save us in our soul's distress; be our help to cheer and bless. While we grow in holiness: Hear us, Holy Jesus. 3. Brighten all our heavenward way with an ever, holier ray till we pass to perfect day: Hear us, Holy Jesus.**

Part VII: "Father, into Your hands I commend My Spirit." - St. Luke 23:46

**P: 1. Jesus, all Your labor vast, all your woe and conflict past; yielding up Your soul at last: Hear us, Holy Jesus. 2, When the death-shades round us lower, guard us from the tempter's power, keep us in that trial hour: Hear us, Holy Jesus. 3. May Your life and death supply grace to live and grace to die, grace to reach the home on high: Hear us, Holy Jesus.**
