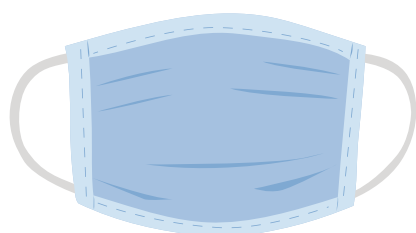


COVID-19 SAFETY GUIDELINES

SOCIAL DISTANCING



Online Sermons are available on our website to those who wish to worship safely at home. The worship service may also be heard on FM 88.1 in St. Paul's parking lot. If you are experiencing fever or recent symptoms of Covid-19; or have been exposed to Covid-19 in the last 14 days please worship from home.



Wearing a mask is required at all times while in the church building unless a health condition prohibits wearing one.

Please keep 6 feet apart between you and other worshippers while in the church building, including in the entranceway, elevator, hallways and Sanctuary.

WHAT TO EXPECT FOR WORSHIP

Please enter the church through the back entrance off the parking lot only. Access to the Sanctuary will be limited to the back stairwell right off the parking lot entrance or the elevator. The hallway to Fellowship Hall will be closed just past the restrooms.



Social distancing will be the new normal for seating in the Sanctuary. Pews will be marked to allow social distancing of at least 6 feet between families or individuals. Please respect the guidelines placed for your protection.

Singing creates the need for social distancing of 25 feet or more, therefore singing unfortunately will not be a part of worship. We do hope to have instrumental and special music as a part of worship.



All hymnals, Bibles, and connection cards will be removed from the back of the pews. Scripture lessons will be in your Celebrate insert in the bulletin.

Communion elements for Communion Sundays will be provided by disposable "Fellowship Cups" for both in Sanctuary worship and those listening to the service in the parking lot.



There will be no Coffee Hour, Children's Church, Nursery, or non-church events in the church building until further notice to keep gatherings in line with social distancing and to allow a proper cleaning and disinfecting schedule to be kept at a minimum.

CLEANING & DISINFECTING



A regular weekly schedule will be followed for cleaning and disinfecting the building, especially high touch areas following worship.

There will be no outside groups using the church facilities until further notice to allow a proper cleaning and disinfecting schedule to be kept to a minimum.

Touch-Free Hand Sanitizer stations will be available to you in the Sanctuary and throughout the church building.
