



MOORHEAD COUNTRY CLUB DRESS CODE POLICY

To preserve the standards and welcoming atmosphere of our Club, members and their guests are expected to maintain a neat, professional appearance while on MCC property.

This policy applies to all individuals age 16 and older. Parents and guardians are encouraged to help children under 16 follow these guidelines when possible.

GOLF COURSE & PRACTICE FACILITIES

Members and their guests are expected to present themselves in a neat and professional manner while on the golf course and practice facilities. The following guidelines apply:

MEN

- Shirts must have a collar and sleeves
- Golf-specific crew necks are acceptable
- Golf shorts or pants are required
- Denim is allowed only if clean and not frayed or excessively worn
- T-shirts are not permitted
- Apparel sold in the Golf Shop is considered acceptable (excluding T-shirts)

WOMEN

- LPGA guidelines apply
- Golf-specific sleeveless and/or collarless shirts are permitted
- Golf-specific leggings (such as those sold in the Golf Shop) are allowed
- No specific length requirement for shorts or skirts
- Athleisure wear is permitted if golf-appropriate

UNACCEPTABLE ON COURSE

- Tank tops with thin straps
- Halter tops, cut-offs
- Sweatpants, gym shorts, T-shirts
- Clothing in poor condition

CLUBHOUSE & SIMULATOR LOUNGE

A professional and appropriate appearance is required in the clubhouse and simulator lounge.

DENIM

- Denim jeans are permitted but must be clean, free of holes, rips, or excessive fading

MEN

- All golf-approved clothing is acceptable
- Business casual is preferred

WOMEN

- All golf-approved clothing is acceptable

UNACCEPTABLE IN CLUBHOUSE

- Tank tops with thin straps
- Halter tops, cut-offs
- Sweatpants, gym shorts, T-shirts
- Pajamas or loungewear
- Pool attire is strictly prohibited in the clubhouse

MEMBER NOTICE

If you have questions or need clarification about the Dress Code policy, please speak with Club Management or Golf Staff.

At all times, **Club Management and Golf Staff retain full discretion to determine what is considered proper and acceptable attire.** They also reserve the right to:

- Refuse service
- Deny access to Club facilities
- Prevent play

...if a member, family member, or guest is not in compliance with the Dress Code or Club procedures.

There are no extenuating circumstances and no exceptions will be made.
