- We have rented the Holy Trinity House, 342 McGinnis Road, Tallapoosa, GA 30176 at Lutheranch from Friday, May 5 at 12pm until Sunday, May 7th at 11am.
- Meet at Holy Trinity House when you can. Please indicate on your registration form if you need a ride. You are encouraged to carpool.
- Check in is 12 pm or after on Friday, May 5th; Check out is 11am on Sunday, May 7.

- Bedding and bath linens, Soap and TP are provided.
- The house sleeps 25. 17 people fit in bottom bunks or non-sharing doubles. The chance you have to climb into a top bunk is slim. 😊
- Beer and wine will be allowed. Hard liquor will not be allowed. You may want to keep drinks in a cooler. BYOB – Water, coffee, tea and other.
- We will be coordinating our own food for Saturday and Sunday breakfasts and Friday and Saturday dinner. You are welcome to bring your own food, if you have a dietary restriction. It would be great if everyone could contribute a food item even if it is a snack item, a store bought food item, or beverages included bottled water.
- Lunch on Saturday will be on your own at one the few restaurants in town or leftovers from Fri eve. Those going to the winery may want to pack a lunch to enjoy there. The food truck that was there last year ran out of food.
- There is a winery nearby that we may want to visit on Saturday– Trillium Vineyard, Bremen. www.trilliumvineyard.com. Visiting the winery is optional.
- The cost is \$75 for the weekend.
- Registration forms are due on **April 1st** with a \$60 deposit (non-refundable).
- Earmark checks “women’s retreat” to avoid any mix-ups in the offering.
- Please dress comfortably; bring an umbrella (just in case), a jacket, games, an outside chair (if you have one).
