## What is Project 2020+?

Project 2020+ is a Professionally-Guided / Kid-Created Original Work. This virtual collaboration is an eight month project designed to give our Kids a creative voice in these extraordinary times; the ridiculous, the tragic, the poignant, and the hilarious! Whether a series of shorts, spoken word or poetry, a painting or digital message, Kids Who Care's professional team of creatives is connecting Kids voices from around the globe. With prompts like "What is Our Now?" and "What would you Change in the World?", this shared art will not only impact Kids lives this spring but will also provide material for Kids Who Care's next original musical previewing at July Camp in 2021.

## How do I Participate in Project 2020+ in 2021?

### These are the Quick and Easy Steps

Students ages 6-18 submit a 1-3 Minute video including all of the following:

- **Slate:** Tell us your name, age, and what you are sharing (a song, a piece of art, etc)
- **Share an example of what you hope to contribute to Project 2020+;** Show us a piece of your art or photography, include a video clip of your work, sing a verse & chorus of your favorite song, share an original dance, show us your costume and scenic design.
- **Tell us why becoming a member of Project 2020+ is important to you.**
- **Let us know "If you could change anything in the world, what it would be?"**
