Open to all Iowa and Illinois artists living within 90 miles of the Quad Cities. All works must be original or prints in a limited edition. Half of exhibited art must have been completed within the last five years. Works must be of high quality, framed and/or display ready (WITH HANGING HARDWARE). Due to the high visibility of our galleries, artists should enter work that is appropriate to all audiences.

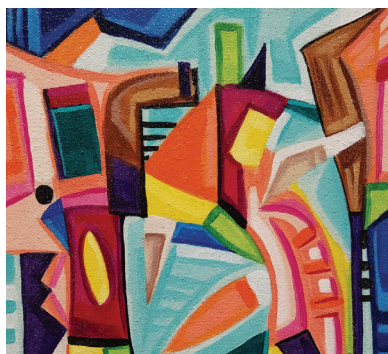

- A check for \$30 (non-refundable jury fee) payable to MidCoast Fine Arts.
- A current artist statement used for promotion and exhibit labeling. Digital format required and may be added to CD or emailed to [info@midcoast.org](mailto:info@midcoast.org).

### ENTRY DEADLINE

Entries must be emailed, delivered or postmarked no later than Wednesday, October 3, 2018.

A notification of jury results and proposed exhibition calendar will be emailed by Monday, November 12, 2018.



### GROUP SHOWS

Group shows will be considered. Please include a total of five images that illustrate the work of the group participants. A brief description of the proposed exhibit—including theme, number of exhibiting artists and their contact information—must accompany the submission. One application and jury fee per group show submission.

### INSTALLATION, PROMOTION, RECEPTIONS AND COMMISSIONS

MidCoast staff will assist with installations, but we do not take responsibility for delivery or pick-up transit. By entering your images, you agree that your artwork images may be shared for publicity with local media, Facebook, email blasts, and posted on MidCoast Fine Arts' website. MidCoast budgets for a modest reception per exhibition: the Final Friday (last Friday of the month and mid-December) at Bucktown; the middle Friday of the month at Gallery West, and by request at Moline Centre Station. MidCoast Fine Arts does not charge a commission on sales in these galleries. If an immediate sale is necessary and MidCoast staff members are not available, the Moline Centre Station gift shop run by MetroLINK charges a 22% commission for processing the sale.

### INSURANCE

Exhibiting artists are responsible for their own insurance for lost or damaged artwork, personal effects or equipment.
