



2020 PENNSYLVANIA ELECTIONS IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

First day to circulate and file nomination petitions	January 28
Last day to circulate and file nomination petitions	February 18
First day to circulate and file nomination papers	February 19
Last day for withdrawal by candidates who filed nomination petitions	March 4
Last day to REGISTER before the primary	April 13
Last day to apply for a mail-in or civilian absentee ballot	April 21
Last day for County Boards of Elections to receive voted mail-in and civilian absentee ballots (must be received by 8:00 P.M.)	April 28
GENERAL PRIMARY	April 28
First day to REGISTER after primary	April 29
Last day for County Boards of Elections to receive voted military and overseas absentee ballots (submitted for delivery no later than 11:59 P.M. on April 27)	May 5

Last day to circulate and file nomination papers	
Last day for withdrawal by candidates nominated by nomination papers	August 10
Last day for withdrawal by candidates nominated at the primary	August 10
Last day to REGISTER before the November election	October 19
Last day to apply for a mail-in or civilian absentee ballot	October 27
Last day for County Boards of Elections to receive voted mail-in and civilian absentee ballots (must be received by 8:00 P.M.)	November 3
GENERAL ELECTION	November 3
First day to REGISTER after November election	November 4
Last day for County Boards of Elections to receive voted military and overseas absentee ballots (submitted for delivery no later than 11:59 P.M. on November 2)	November 10
