PTA Bachelor's Degree Requirements

- Attendance (Virtual for 2020) at a VAPTA Summer Leadership Training
- Attendance at a PTA District or Council meeting or workshop; this may include a District Annual Meeting/ Conference or training event, or Council workshop, training or Annual Meeting
- Specific position training workshop – President, Treasurer, Secretary, Bylaws, Arts in Education (Reflections), etc.
- Completion of a one (1) year term of office at any level of PTA, as an officer or committee chair

PTA Master's Degree Requirements

- Completion of the PTA Bachelor's Degree
- Attend PTA Advocacy Day in Richmond
- Select four (4) electives - can be obtained online with National PTA eLearning courses, state/district/council training events:
 - Cultural Competency
 - National Standard for Family School Partnership
 - Parliamentary Procedure
 - Membership Basics
 - Bylaws and Standing Rules
 - Preventing Theft in Your PTA
 - Present a workshop at state/district/council PTA training event



PTA Doctoral Degree Requirements

- Completion of the PTA Bachelor's Degree
- Completion of the PTA Master's Degree
- Completion of a "Thesis Project"
 - Submit a Resolution
 - Host a forum on any topic (family engagement, mental health, equity and diversity, etc.)
 - Create an approved training course including presentation
