Daniel Bartholomew-Poyser is assistant conductor of the Kitchener-Waterloo Symphony.

Mr. Poyser has conducted concerts in the KWS Pops Series as well as conducting the senior Youth Orchestra of the KWS's nationally recognized program. He also works with the KWS Education and Community Programs department, conducting and hosting the KWS School Concerts and concerts in the Family series.

He studied tuba and music education at the University of Calgary, earning the Faculty of Fine Arts Gold Medal. At England's Royal Northern College of Music he received a number of awards and a Master's of Philosophy in Conducting Performance.

Mr. Poyser has appeared as a guest conductor with the Calgary Philharmonic, Rochester Philharmonic and Symphony Nova Scotia. He was associate conductor of the Thunder Bay Symphony Orchestra before being appointed assistant conductor at Kitchener-Waterloo Symphony.
