LEADERSHIP & LEMONADE: INFORMATION SHEET

WHAT:

- A flexible & innovative scaled-back version of the Leadership Cortland & Tompkins programs for 2021.
- Each month, Community Leaders from Cortland and Tompkins counties will be selected around a theme and tell us their LEMONADE story.
- Participants will get to ask questions to learn about leadership in action & crisis leadership.
- Each month will also have a mini-leadership lesson.
- Sessions will be virtual via Zoom until it is safe to resume meeting in-person.

WHEN:

- Monthly sessions running from February through October of 2021.
- Held the 2nd Friday of every month from 9am to 11am.
- Session dates are: Feb 12, March 12, April 9, May 14, June 11, July 9, Aug 13, Sept 10, Oct 8

- These sessions are open to anyone who is interested.
- If you have participated in Leadership Cortland or Leadership Tompkins in the past, these will be a great way for you to reconnect to the programs!
