RULES AND INFORMATION

Please keep this page for your reference

1. Floats, vehicles, horses, and motorcycles must have lights on them. Walkers must have lights or reflective tape. Recommended, but not required: minimum 1000 lights on floats, 250 lights on vehicles, 100 lights on horses and motorcycles, 25 lights (or reflective tape) on walkers. **MORE IS BETTER!** Vehicles towing floats are also welcome to be decorated with lights.
2. Walkers accompanying floats should be dressed in holiday attire or uniform.
3. Floats are encouraged to decorate in line with the theme, but it is not required
4. No candy can be thrown from any entry during the parade due to safety concerns. Please abide by this rule. Walkers may hand out candy along the route.
5. Group signage is encouraged so that spectators know who or what you are representing.
5. **Winfield Main Street will provide the only Santa in the parade.**
6. We reserve the right to refuse participation of any entry deemed inappropriate.

PARADE DAY INFORMATION

Line-up:

- You will be emailed a map of the line-up the week before the parade. Lineup is on 17th Street on either side of Main. Line-up will begin at 5:15 p.m.
All entries must be in line by 6:10 pm. The parade will begin at 6:30 pm.
- Once you are in line, you will be visited by a parade official and given a number that will need to be displayed on the right side of your entry so that it is visible to the judges and announcers as you proceed past the stage in front of Community National Bank and Trust.

Route:

- The route is from 17th Ave. to 10th Ave on Main Street
- At 10th, you will be directed by a parade official to turn off Main Street.

During the parade:

- Please be sure to stop in front of the stage at Community National Bank & Trust for the announcers to read your group's information and for your entry to be judged.
- Please watch the distance between your entry and the one you are following. Do not crowd. Keep all routines moving, this includes all dance studios, bands, color guards, and so forth.
