Richard Rodriguez is currently serving as the Veterans Services Coordinator at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University. In May of 2018, he began his employment at ERAU directly after graduating with Honors from the University's College of Aviation with a Bachelor of Science in Aeronautics.

Richard is a retired U. S. Navy SEAL Platoon Chief from SEAL Team Three, serving 20 years in Special Operations. He led Foxtrot Platoon in the initial invasion of Iraq in 2003, in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. His actions as Assault Team Leader won him the Bronze Star with Combat "V" for valor during the assault. Immediately following the assault he assisted in the March to Baghdad, Foxtrot Platoon conducted numerous covert operations and multiple counter-insurgent engagements. While helping to secure the city if Baghdad, Richard was called on to give support to the U. S. Marine Corps as a counter-sniper. He provided over watch and cover during unit movement throughout the city along with hunting enemy snipers. These actions would earn him the nickname "The Boogie Man" in country.
