

Sheriff David Rhodes is a 32-year veteran of the Yavapai County Sheriff's Office. He began his career as a volunteer, making it official in 1994 and promoting his way through the ranks in positions of Sergeant, Lieutenant, Captain and Chief Deputy. A graduate of the FBI National Academy, Session #244, he served as the Commander in both the Law Enforcement Division and the Detention Division of the Sheriff's Office. Sheriff Rhodes also served as the Commander of the Northern Arizona Regional Training Academy, which provides education and training to future law enforcement officers from around the state of Arizona. He has since served as the President of the Arizona Sheriff's Association and is a current Board Member of the National Sheriff's Association. He was elected Sheriff in November of 2020 and reelected in 2024.
