Cindy Casaus was elected treasurer of the National Federation of Republican Women (NFRW) at the 42nd Biennial Convention in Oklahoma City and took office in January 2024. She is the director of NFRW Region 8, which includes Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan and Wisconsin. She also is the advisor to the NFRW Homeland Security Committee.

A third-generation Arizonan and longtime grassroots Republican volunteer committed to public service, Cindy previously served on the NFRW Campaign Committee. In 2022, Cindy was the recipient of the National Republican Senatorial Committee's Champion of Freedom Award.

Cindy earned a bachelor's degree in accountancy from Arizona State University's W.P. Carey School of Business and has worked in both the private and public sectors for over 20 years. Throughout her career she has worked as a chief financial officer, accounting & operations manager, chief of operations & communications, and assistant director.

She is the vice president of the St. John Bosco Catholic School Advisory Board, a board member of the school's PTO, and has served in various volunteer roles at her parish, including president of the mother's ministry. She also serves as the President of the Arizona Construction Career Days (AZCCD), a 501C3 Non-Profit Organization focused on connecting high school students with construction-industry professional in an effort to grow workforce in Arizona and *Building Tomorrow's Workforce Today*.
