



THE WARREN COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL FORUM

The International Energy Agency estimates that it would only require spending an additional 2% of annual global GDP (the equivalent of \$1.7 trillion annually) to achieve a net-zero carbon economy!



The US EPA estimates that pollutants carried by rainwater runoff account for 70% of all water pollution. Rain gardens can remove up to 90% of nutrients and chemicals as well as up to 80% of sediments from rainwater runoff! 3
