COVID VACCINATION SITE # 2:

We wanted to let you know of a vaccine opportunity being held at our office in White River Jct, VT. We currently have very low registration, so we thought you might help us get to word out.

Tuesday and Thursday this week (1/11/22 and 1/13/22) and next (1/18/22 and 1/20/22) and Tuesday 1/25/22 we will be offering vaccine clinics. The morning (9:30 to 1:30) is all adult vaccines (Pfizer 12+, Moderna and limited Janssen) AND the afternoon (2-4) we will offer only Pfizer (both 12+ and 5-11 formulations).
