The Lord relocated my family and I from upstate New York to minister in Upstate Minnesota in July of 2020. But let him ask in faith, with no doubting...”* Instantly, man-made pressure to perform was removed and the Spirit of the Lord began to open doors and answer questions for our Leadership team from that point on. What made this even easier was the grace & love shown by the body and the wisdom of our Elders. The whole church remained focused on glorifying God, making every Scriptural decision necessary for the direction of the church to be made with confidence and peace of mind. Without Him, I am not sure how my transition would have gone in the midst of earthly uncertainty.

We had a desire to find a way to minister to our various shut-ins and make sure they know they are still included in church and cared for. After much prayer, several people in the church came up with a prayer action program. Each month we'll be sending out a newsletter with all the church info and activities for that month and a specific topic to pray for. Each week, I'll be posting a devotional to add specifics to the prayed upon topic, and a dedicated group of people will be calling, sending cards, and if possible, visiting our shut-ins. Hopefully, this will allow people to feel included, active, and cared for.

We have been blessed to see a hunger grow for the truth of Jesus Christ and I believe God has used this virus to help increase this passion in the lives of men and women around us. There is no question that the glory of the Lord shines all around us. As the apostle Paul says in *Romans 8:31 – “...If God is for us, who can be against us?”*
