Gospel Centered Obedience

Text: Acts 2:37-47

Summary: Church is busy!! Metaphors abound that paint pictures describing the activity seemingly required to keep church ministry thriving: spinning plates, juggling balls, herding cats, hamsters running on a wheel. Do you experience ministry in the local church as endless exhaustion with little peace or depth of relationship with God and His people? Perhaps the problem is not that church ministry is hard and requires diligent labors (it is and it does!!!). Perhaps the bigger problem is that church life has grown too complicated, too complex. The story of the church's launch and growth in Acts helps us to apply the simplicity that God designed for His church. Simple beginning. Simple commitments. Simple purpose. In this breakout we will discuss how Elders can be spiritually healthy while leading a church to health.
