The program includes five different positions that correspond to five different ministry areas within First Baptist Church.

The internship program is a ministry training program. This means we want to strengthen our ties with other churches by inviting, or recruiting, Christians who are passionate about receiving ministry training, to our church. Throughout the 10-month program, we want our interns to apply their

training to service in this local church and community. We also want to mobilize our interns to be sent to their desired ministry contexts for a continued life of Kingdom service.

Do you know anyone in your career network who would be a good fit for this ministry training program? Who are some particular people that come to mind? We would enjoy interviewing some high caliber applicants from YOUR church community, and send them back to their home church better equipped for ministry because of the training they received from First.

While the preferred deadline to apply is April 7, 2019 we will continue interviewing applicants until all five positions are filled.
