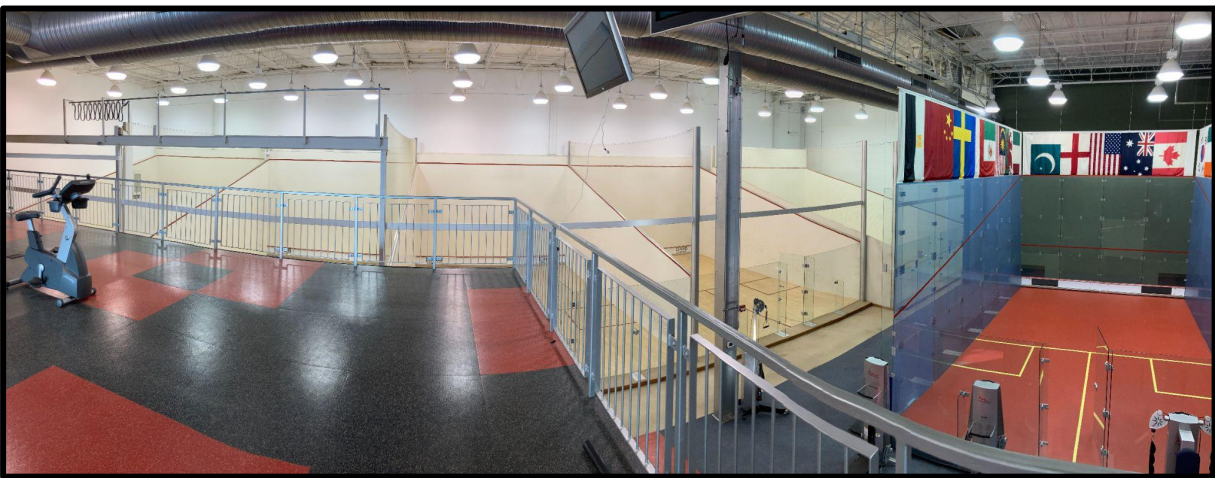




Since the inception of First State Squash in 2016, we have delivered critical out-of-school time youth development programming to some of Wilmington’s most underserved communities.

The facility will enable First State Squash to serve 100+ Wilmington youths by 2025 and is in close proximity to our partner schools and the neighborhoods of our families.

Over the coming months, we plan to transform our new headquarters into more than just an exceptional athletic facility. 524 S Walnut Street will also house First State Squash’s classrooms and offices, and will be a center our team members can call their own.

As we look to the future, our goal is to create a home for aspiring athletes, dedicated students and community leaders to further pursue their high school, college and workforce goals.
