

INCREDIBLE YEARS PARENT WORKSHOP

The Incredible Years program is used throughout the school with our teachers and children in order to promote positive behaviors. The parent workshops are part of this overall program, and provide practical solutions to everyday problems you may face with your child. The topics that will be covered include:

- How to manage specific problem behaviors
- How to address negative behaviors in the home
- How to use praise and rewards to promote positive behaviors
- A new approach towards playing with your child to promote learning
- How to improve limit setting with your child

These hour-long workshops will be presented at NIS over an eight-week period, with daytime and evening times available. The groups will run on Wednesdays, starting October 16th through December 4th.
