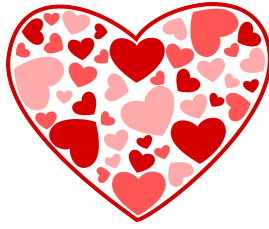


Valentine's Day Scavenger Hunt



Looking for an easy and fun activity to do inside? Go on a scavenger hunt! Cut out some hearts and hide them around the house-your child will love looking for them.

A few tips:

- ❖ “Hiding” something does not need to be tricky-you can scatter them around a room in plain sight, tape them to the wall, or give directions to have your child look in specific places. It’s a great way to work on following directions, body awareness, and visual perceptual skills.
- ❖ Let your child take a turn “hiding” the hearts for you to find.
- ❖ Collect the hearts and make a collage by gluing them on paper.
- ❖ Make hearts different sizes and colors! Challenge your child to find specific ones (big or small, one color at a time,
- ❖ Write the letters in your child’s name on hearts and have them find and assemble their name.
- ❖ Use Valentine’s Day cards (the classroom sets would work well) instead of pre cut hearts.
